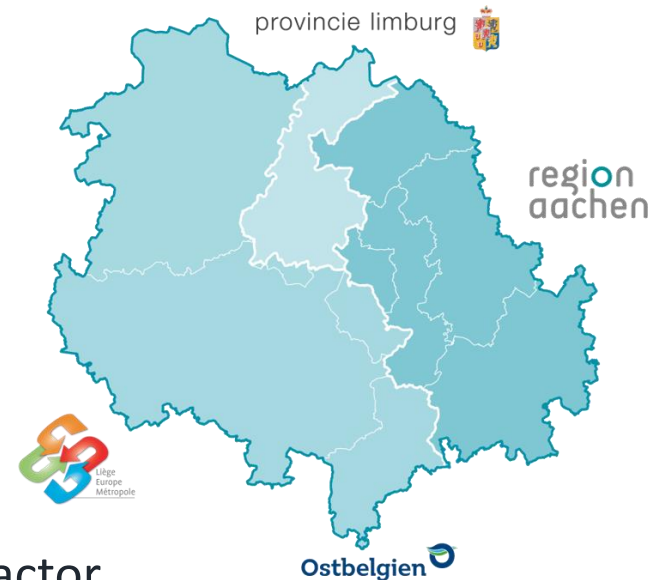
Advantages of cross-border cooperation and projects

Living in the cross-border region

- Euregio as an international living and residential space
→ Whether living, working or leisure, many journeys take place across borders
- Breaking down boundaries as a goal and way of life for EMR residents →
Transgression is hardly perceived today
- Create data and decision basis for joint spatial planning → uniform,
comparable & (eu)regionally usable
- So far we only have assumptions hardly provable with data
e.g.: From which municipalities do particularly large numbers of people move
abroad and to what can this be attributed? Are housing market factors
responsible for this?
